Dear Colleague,

The Police Rehabilitation Centre, Flint House is a registered charity that was established in 1890 to provide treatment to serving police officers. Since then the charity has grown and developed, but the fundamental aim remains to get police officers back to health quickly.

We are situated in South Oxfordshire and help over 3500 officers a year from the southern police forces by providing a 12 day residential programme for either physiotherapy or mental health. The police officers themselves pay for the charity by regular voluntary contributions and in return the treatment they receive at Flint House is free of charge.

Our clinical staff assess each patient by reviewing their application prior to allocating dates for treatment. To ensure this is at the appropriate level and encouraging continuity of care we ask patients to have their applications signed off by their GP and provide contact details for discharge reports.

As we are a charity, in order to support the officers and in acknowledgment of the treatment that Flint House is able to offer your patient, we would be most grateful if you would consider not charging for completing their form.
